SUBJECT: Out-Year Forecasts

You asked the following questions:

1. What is OFA's most recent Current Services out-year forecast?

OFA has not produced a full out-year forecast for FY16-FY18 since November 15, 2013. However, revenues have been updated in January 2014 as a result of the consensus revenue process. Based on a utilization of November 2013 expenditures and January 2014 revenues in order to generate a more up to date forecast, the following deficits are calculated:

2. Does the Governor's budget proposal increase or decrease OFA's out-year deficit forecast?

The Governor's budget proposal increases OFA's out-year deficit forecast by the following:

3. Does the Appropriations and Finance Committees' budget/revenue proposal increase or decrease OFA's out-year deficit forecast?

The Appropriations and Finance Committees' budget/revenue proposal increases OFA's out-year deficit forecast by the following:

Above/(Below) OFA	181.8	185.9	193.4

4. Does the Republican Alternative budget proposal of 4/17/14 increase or decrease OFA's out-year deficit forecast?

The Republican Alternative budget proposal of 4/17/14 decreases OFA's out-year deficit forecast by the following:
